Foster Family Expectations

- A foster family should attend at least one (1) NDR event a month.
- Should the family be unable to attend an event they should make every attempt to get their foster dog to the event
- A foster family should maintain regular contact with their Foster Advocate.
 - This would include responding to email and phone messages in a timely manner.
- Sign a Hold Harmless Agreement
- Ensure the foster dog is provided with food, water, shelter, exercise and love
- Ensure the foster dog receives medical care when necessary
- Ensure the foster dog receives heart worm meds on a monthly basis
